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## KALIYUGA ARTS PRESENTS IN CIRCLES AL CARMINES' MUSICAL MASTERPIECE AT JUDSON MEMORIAL CHURCH FEB 12 THROUGH 22, 2008

<u>In Circles</u>, Al Carmines' 1968 Obie-award-winning musical romp through Gertrude Stein's <u>A Circular Play</u>, will be revived by Kaliyuga Arts for ten performances only, February 12 - 22, 2008 at the place where it premiered, Judson Memorial Church in Greenwich Village. This will mark the first New York production of one of Mr. Carmines' theatre pieces since his death in 2005, and the producers hope that this , along with Judson Church's recent staging of his holiday oratorio <u>Christmas Rappings</u>, will spark renewed interest in his work.

The production will be directed and designed by John Sowle, choreographed by Jack Dyville, and will feature an all-Equity cast including Paul Boesing, Sarah Ferro, Meghan Hales, Michael Lazar, Paul Lincoln, Robin Manning, Noelle McGrath, Steven Patterson, Maureen Taylor and Anthony Wills Jr.

<u>In Circles</u> will be Kaliyuga Arts' third New York production following its successful staging of Samuel Beckett's <u>All That Fall</u> at the Cherry Lane and the Innovative Theatre Award nominated production of Dan Carbone's <u>Kingdom of Not</u>. It will also be Kaliyuga's second production of <u>In Circles</u>, which it presented to critical acclaim in Los Angeles in 1986, winning five Drama-Loque awards.

In Circles is a beautiful recapturing of that time early in the  $20^{\rm th}$  century when art seemed to be a Paris of the mind where all sensitive spirits could live in a universal communion of form, wit, and feeling.
